
The children have learnt how to solve problems on their own or with the help of others.

The Ofsted Framework

Bullying falls under the key judgement '*Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare.*'

Schools will need to show the impact of their anti-bullying policies along with demonstrating that they meet a range of other anti-bullying criteria....our award will help schools to evidence this!

The Beyond Bullying Award is valid for 3 years. Schools sign up for renewal after 2 years so that their accreditation can be re-validated at the end of year 3.
